1. We received a number of calls this week of 25 people fighting in a street in Dodleston. When officers did attend they discovered that there had been a disturbance and some damage had occurred to a motor vehicle. We have prosecuted one person in relation to this and the matter is now closed.
2. Speed enforcement took place this week in No Mans Heath. We reported 3 speeding motorists and one person was reported for improper use of his mobile telephone.

We launched a joint initiative this week with the Cheshire Mobile Library Service where we will seek to accompany them on parts of their round and conduct 1 hour surgeries in some of our more outlying villages. This will serve the purpose of allowing people using the Library service to also see a local officer and in turn raise issues with them. We will be publishing these dates on the Constabulary Website.
4. Sightings please for an Isuzu Trooper index number J475EDM. This vehicle comes from the Lache area and has been sighted at the scenes of thefts of trailers in Hampton and surrounding areas. We are making efforts to trace the driver, but would request any sightings to us.
5. We had a burglary reported to us this week in Hare Lane Guilden Sutton where some bikes were stolen. Any sightings of suspicious characters please.
6. We have had an attempted break in at The Spar shop in Elton this week. 2 men were seen to tamper with the alarm box before making off in a White Ford Fiesta with a number similar to N825VKD. Sightings please.
7. I am grateful to the residents of Farndon who chased off some men from an elderly gentleman's property who were cold calling. The occupants of a White Transit index number NL56AHD were challenged by locals and made off after commencing unsolicited work and I will be passing their details to Trading Standards.
