1. Sightings please for a Ford Transit van with a partial number of MW51. This was seen by an off duty Pc acting suspiciously in Churton with 4 men onboard.
2. Sightings for a Ford Transit van no registration number taken that was seen acting suspiciously in Tattenhall looking for scrap metal.
3. We had two burglaries this week at lunchtime in Backford. Two men broke into houses and made off with electrical goods. They were pursued by Cheshire patrols along the motorway and lost in Liverpool. We later recovered the vehicle they were using and it was stolen from Manchester. Clearly there are people out and about committing burglaries during daylight hours in our area and I would ask as always for any reports of suspicious characters.
4. A house was broken into on Hockenhull Avenue Tarvin over the weekend during the early evening. It appears that the offenders were disturbed and we are appealing for information from anyone who saw suspicious vehicles or persons in the area.
5. We had reports this week of a person firing an airgun and a catapults in Kelsall trying to damage the windows of houses. If anyone has information regarding this please contact Pc Rob Elliott at Mickle Trafford Police station.
