## Western Rural Round-up-

1. Stop checks on a White Ford Transit index number SV53UOK. This vehicle was acting suspiciously in Malpas with 3 Males aboard who were described as having Irish accents who were asking for scrap.
2. We executed a number of warrants relating to drugs this week in Elton. We searched 3 addresses and uncovered a large Cannabis cultivation operation in progress. 3 local people were arrested and bailed pending further enquiries.
3. We ran Operation Maldives this week during the night with our counterparts in North Wales and West Mercia to tackle travelling car and burglary offenders. We made several arrests and recovered two girls who were missing from home.
4. Sightings please for two Ford Transit type vans. The first van was grey, yellow index number W49NRP. The second was a red tipper type Transit index number K538WCX. Callers reported the vehicles around Alford and Eccleston acting suspiciously around tea time on Wednesday.
5. Reports of a prowler being disturbed in Mickle Trafford around 11.30pm on Wednesday. The prowler was found hiding in a garden and ran off when challenged.
6. Sightings please for a Landrover Discovery index number P76MWP. This vehicle is of interest to me and is out and about all across the rural.
7. Sightings please for a Landrover B853 LRS. This vehicle was stop checked by my staff in Malpas and originates from the Liverpool.
